The beers on this menu are listed starting with those that are lighter and very mild in taste, progressing to the beers that are darker and more potent in taste, grouped into three color categories:

STRAW / GOLDEN GROUP – Includes American & Euro lagers (helles), pilsners, Kolach, Abbey-style triples, golden ale, blondes and most wheat beers.

AMBER / COPPER GROUP – More flavorful beer styles and include: pale ales (American, English & Belgian), India Pale Ale, dark wheat beers, bocks & dopplebocks, English bitter, amber ales, red ales, Marzen / Oktoberfest, and Vienna/amber lagers.

BROWN / BLACK GROUP – Some potent tasting beers and some easier drinking and clean finishing (for instance, dunkels, black lagers and dry stouts). Common brown styles include: black lager (schwarzbier), dry stout, dunkel, brown ales, sour brown ales (often barrel-aged), dubbels, oatmeal stout, imperial stout, milk stout, and porters.
