Next in development was the Song of America, a ship larger than her sisters and featuring a new and improved Viking Crown Lounge positioned around the ship's funnel - a design so iconic that it lasts to this day and is featured by many in Royal Caribbean's fleet.

As the need for construction grew, Royal Caribbean expanded the builder network throughout Europe, including the Sovereign class, the first megaships built by Royal Caribbean in Saint-Nazaire, France.

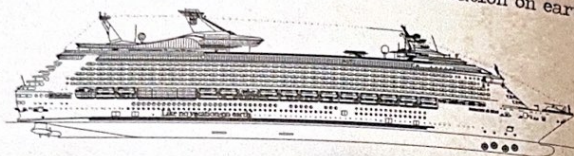
The Millennium - Voyager Class

Voyager ushered Royal Caribbean International into the new millennium and set the new standard for cruising, with the tag line "Like no vacation on earth!"

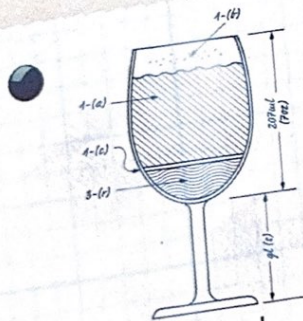
